

# Who is SANTA CLAUS

## Who is Father Christmas?

Father Christmas is our version of Santa Claus. He is an old jolly man with white hair, a beard and a moustache. He is dressed in a red suit outlined in white. Father Christmas and his elves make all the toys for Christmas in his home in the North Pole. \*The red coat is new\*. Most pictures showed him with a green coat. The red became the most popular color after the US introduction by Coca Cola during the 1930s.



## History of Father Christmas in England

Father Christmas was originally part of an old English winter festival, normally dressed in green, a sign of the returning spring. He was known as 'Sir Christmas', 'Old Father Christmas' or 'Old Winter'. At the beginning, Father Christmas was not the bringer of gifts for small children and he did not come down the chimney. He simply walked from home to home, knocking on doors and eating with families before going to the next house.

## Who is Santa Claus?

Santa Claus is based on a real person, St. Nicholas. St. Nicholas, or Sinter Klaas in Dutch, was a very shy man and wanted to give money to poor people without them knowing about it. One day, he climbed the roof of a house and dropped a purse of money down the chimney. It landed in the stocking which a girl had put to dry by the fire! This can explain the belief that Father Christmas comes down the chimney and places gifts in children's stockings.
