Testy wstępne, postępu i końcowe dla szkoleń z języka angielskiego

w ramach projektu „Akademia kompetencji kluczowych –
program rozwoju uczniów szkół ponadgimnazjalnych Polski Wschodniej”

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Cel i budowa testu

Niniejszy test podstawowy składa się z 60-ciu zadań i posłuży do wyłonienia osób, które zostaną zakwalifikowane na kurs języka angielskiego, a w trakcie jego trwania – do monitorowania postępów i oceny zdobytej wiedzy. Zestaw został podzielony na trzy części w zależności od stopnia trudności danego zadania. W ostatecznej wersji elektronicznej dla kandydatów na uczestników szkolenia, na test złoży się 30 zadań wybranych po dziesięć z każdego poziomu trudności. Do testu podstawowego dołączono 20 zadań rezerwowych, którymi można uzupełnić zestaw podstawowy w drugim i trzecim etapie testowania.

Ze względu na typ zadań, jest to tzw. zamknięty test wyboru, którego prawidłowe rozwiązanie polega w każdym przypadku na wybraniu jednej poprawnej odpowiedzi spośród czterech sugerowanych – A, B, C, D. Biorąc pod uwagę zakres testowanej wiedzy, poprzez poszczególne zadania testowe ewaluacji podlega znajomość gramatyki i słownictwa. Testowane zagadnienia gramatyczne i leksykalne wchodzą w zakres wymagań programowych określonych przez Ministerstwo Edukacji Narodowej (zob. Program Kursu) jako obowiązujące dla szkół ponadgimnazjalnych. Test jest skonstruowany w ten sposób, że skala trudności wzrasta stopniowo, tzn. uczeń rozwiązuje zadania od najprostszych, na poziomie podstawowym (elementary), po trudniejsze, na poziomie wyższym średniozaawansowanym (upper-intermediate). Uczeń nie jest informowany o zróżnicowaniu skali trudności testu, a o swoim wyniku dowiaduje się dopiero po zakończeniu rozwiązywania wszystkich zadań testowych.

Na poziomie gramatyki zagadnienia testowe obejmują:

- czasy gramatyczne (zdania twierdzące, przeczenia, pytania)
- czasowniki modalne
- rzeczowniki i przedimki
- zaimki osobowe, dzierżawcze, wskazujące, zwrotne
- zaimki nieokreślone i określniki ilościowe



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- przysłówki
- przymiotniki i przysłówki
- przyimki
- spójniki
- strona bierna, tryb rozkazujący, formy czasownika (konstrukcje z bezokolicznikiem i rzeczownikiem odczasownikowym)
- szyk i zgodność wyrazów w zdaniu (inwersja w krótkich odpowiedziach, okoliczniki, przysłówki częstotliwości)
- zdania podrzędne warunkowe (okresy warunkowe)
- Zdania podrzędne okolicznikowe
- zdania przydawkowe
- mowa zależna

Na poziomie słownictwa zagadnienia testowe obejmują m.in.:

- kolokacje
- przyimki z przymiotnikami i czasownikami
- wyrażenia rzeczownikowe
- wyrażenia przyimkowe
- czasowniki frazowe
- idiomy

Ocena testu

Do ustalenia. Proponowany jest system procentowy przy założeniu: za każde poprawnie rozwiązane zadanie uczeń otrzymuje 1 punkt, w sumie jest ich 60, co stanowi 100%. Próg zdawalności zostanie ustalony w zależności od poziomu wiedzy osób zdających test oraz liczby miejsc na szkoleniu w danym czasie i może on zostać podniesiony bądź obniżony.
