1. Glaciers store about 75 % of the world's freshwater.
2. Today more than 25 % of the earth's land is covered in glacier.
3. Gravity causes ice masses to move from high to lower ground.
4. Glaciers decreases in size if it loses more ice and snow than it accumulates.
5. A thicker glacier moves more slowly than less thicker one.
6. Piles and ridges of glacial till are called moraines.
7. Polar bears live in the Arctic.
8. In 1912 Roald Amundsen and his explorers were the first to reach the South Pole.
9. Scientist study ice cores from glaciers to see how air composition has changed over the time.
10. Toboggan Glacier in Alaska has doubled in size.
