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3. Find the answers to those questions:

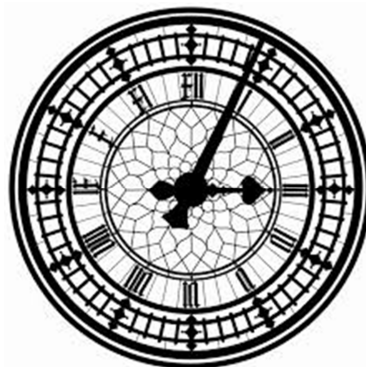
- ❖ What is the name of the river that flows through London?
