

Skeletal system

TOPIC : movement, bones, skeletal system

LEVEL : intermediate

Time : 45 minutes

Objectives:

- to learn or revise vocabulary connected with skeletal system and movement
- to learn about the skeletal system
- to develop reading, speaking and listening comprehension skills
- to enable students use the Internet to gather specific information

Language functions:

- to exchange ideas about skeletal system
- to understand a written text
- to communicate in English
