TOPIC : museums, monuments, UNESCO heritage, geography, nature

LEVEL : intermediate/ upper intermediate

Time : 45 minutes

Objectives:

- to learn or revise vocabulary connected with tourist attractions and heritage
- to learn about UNESCO Heritage sites in Poland
- to develop reading, speaking and listening comprehension skills
 - to enable students use the Internet to gather specific information

Language functions:

- to exchange ideas about Unesco
- to understand a listening material and written text
 - to communicate in English

CLIL: Geography, IT Technology

MATERIALS: websites, worksheets, map of Poland
